APOSTLE TO THE GENTILES

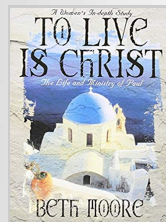

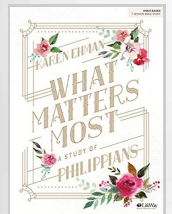
WHAT MATTERS MOST: A STUDY ON PHILIPPIANS by Karen Ehman
