#### KONA WITH JONAH by Sandra Glahn



## ALL THINGS NEW: A Study on II Corinthians by Kelly Minter

This study is for the young women of our church whether you are in college, career or busy wrestling kids at home.

The city of ancient Corinth was much like our own modern-day cities: a melting pot of electrifying cultural experiences to be had. along with the myriad pitfalls of spiritual depravity. The letter of Il Corinthians is an example to us that God's church is meant to thrive in any city and every circumstance in which we find ourselves. Paul's letter is as timely as ever.

We will walk through the Letter of II Corinthians, exploring the anchoring truths of bearing treasures in jars of clay, meeting Christ through a pressing thorn, opening wide our hearts in the midst of hurtful relationships, and what it means to embrace the lost and lonely as ministers of the new covenant. Each of us has a message to proclaim and live by: Because of Jesus the old has gone, the new has come. This study will begin in the winter for the young women's group and continue on through the spring session.
