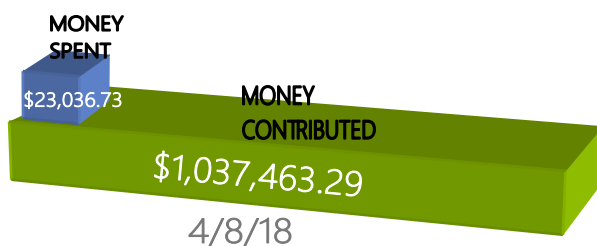
LOVE SERVES MINISTRY
