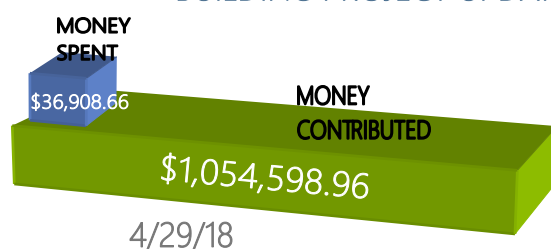
MENTORING LUNCHEON . . . MAY 20
