### WONDER WOMAN BRUNCH . . . MAY 18

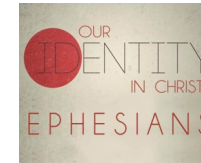

"To Err Is Human, But To Forgive . . ."  
Ephesians 4:30-32

Speaking Today: Pastor Norm Schwab

Every day we face opportunities to forgive people who offend and irritate us, malign and steal from us. *How is it possible to forgive those who have hurt us so deeply?*

1. Responses to injury. (verses 31-32)

2. Who does it hurt? (verse 30)

3. Why don't we forgive? (verse 32)

a. Lies we believe

b. Don't need

c. Too bad

d. Forgotten God

4. How can we forgive?

### Next Step:

Picture that person who has caused you injury. Choose to stop focusing your thoughts on the hurt they have caused. Instead feed your mind with thoughts of who you are and what God has done for you. We can't do this by ourselves. It's too hard. Pray in faith that the Holy Spirit will give you power to forgive.
