Speaking Today: Pastor Norm Schwab

Our temptation is to cover up and hide our weaknesses and inadequacies and then think what we need is simply to become stronger for next time. We assume we can handle anything life throws at us . . . until we can't. What if we really grasped Jesus' supreme power over all . . . even when it doesn't appear to look like it? What is it that we most need?

1. Who's in charge? (verses 18-22)

2. How am I connected? (verses 22-23)

3. How do I tap into His power (that is also mine)? (verses 19-21)

Next Step:

Will you stop right now and ask God to help you get out of the way? Ask God to reveal to you where it is you're still afraid. The more you acknowledge weakness, the more evident is God's enabling strength in your life. Through weakness, I become strong . . . strange but true.
