Speaking Today: Pastor Norm Schwab

The Spirit's filling is far more than feeling goose bumps in Sunday morning worship. It is intensely practical and will have a profound impact in all our relationships: marriage, family and employment.

Spirit-filled living . . .

- 1. What does it look like?
 - a. Joyful communication (verses 18-19)
 - b. Thankful (verse 20)
 - c. Submissive; serving each other (verse 21)
- 2. How can you know if you are filled?

3. How do you get filled?

Next Step:

If you find yourself lacking a joy in singing praise, a thankful heart for all God has done or a desire to serve others well (especially those closest to you), ask yourself: "What things am I doing to open up my capacity to be influenced by the Holy Spirit? What is in my life that is making it difficult for me to become more filled?" What will you do about it?
