**“Lasting Impact Leadership”**

Nehemiah 5:14-19

We are all leaders in some area of life. God determines the size and scope of our leadership. Young or old, it doesn't matter. People in our sphere of influence are watching. How do I become someone worth following? How do I become a leader who builds trust? What kind of things do high-impact leaders pursue?

***To become a leader who makes a difference...***

1. Recognize Who put you there. (verse 14)
2. Sacrificially serve. (verse 15)
3. Fear God more than people. (verse 15)
4. Work hard. (verse 16)
5. Be generous. (verses 17, 18)
6. Foster a heart for the hurting. (verse 18)
7. Look to a greater reward. (verse 19)
