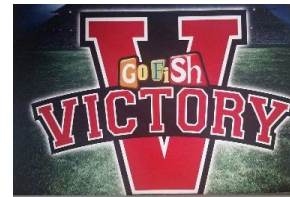

Speaking Today: Pastor Norm Schwab

I need insight. I need practical wisdom for real life. Certainly God's Word will tell me what wisdom looks like, but I need more than just hearing God's Word. I need more than just studying and reading God's Word. In order to gain insight and practice wisdom and the celebrative joy that comes with it, I must apply God's principles.

The only truth that makes any difference is the one that I put into practice.

How can I gain insight and the joy that comes along with it?

1. Receive God's Word. (verses 13-14)
2. Apply God's Word. (verses 15-17)
3. Celebrate God's Word. (verse 17)
