

"Motivating Change" Ephesians 4:17-21

Speaking Today: Pastor Norm Schwab

Paul motivates us to change. He knows we need it. Unless the root of our problem is addressed, the practical path he lays out for us in the rest of his letter will be pointless. Paul believes its essential that we clearly see the contrast of where we used to be and then live in keeping with who we now are in Christ. That's really the key. Paul wants us to learn Christ, for it is our view of Jesus that determines how I practically will live every day.
