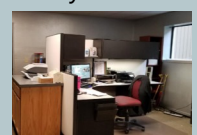
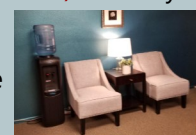
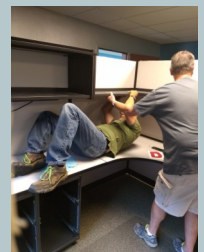


CHANGES ARE HAPPENING!!!
