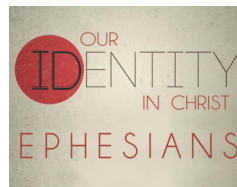

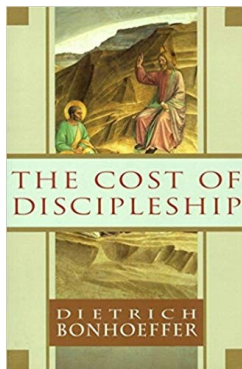

## RECOMMENDED READING...



### THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP by Dietrich Bonhoeffer

One of the most important theologians of the twentieth century illuminates the relationship between ourselves and the teachings of Jesus. What can the call to discipleship, the adherence to the word of Jesus, mean today to the businessman, the soldier, the laborer, or the aristocrat? What did Jesus mean to say to us? What is his will for us today? Drawing on the Sermon on the Mount, Dietrich Bonhoeffer answers these timeless questions by providing a seminal reading of the dichotomy between "cheap grace" and "costly grace." "Cheap grace," Bonhoeffer wrote, "is the grace we bestow on ourselves...grace without discipleship....Costly grace is the gospel which must be sought again and again, the gift which must be asked for, the door at which a man must know....It is costly because it costs a man his life, and it is grace because it gives a man the only true life."

*The Cost of Discipleship* is a compelling statement of the demands of sacrifice and ethical consistency from a man whose life and thought were exemplary articulations of a new type of leadership inspired by the Gospel, and imbued with the spirit of Christian humanism and a creative sense of civic duty.

## DRESSES FOR AFRICA/GUATEMALA

Our missionaries have taken over 50 dress to Africa and about 44 dresses to Guatemala. Those who make the dresses are so pleased knowing each dress is handed to a child in need.

But they have a need now. All of their material for the dress has been donated and now they are running out of material. It is the donations that keep them going.

They make 5 sizes using a different length for each size. No two dresses are alike. When the dresses go with the missionaries, a pair of panties are tucked in a pocket in the dresses. Pockets are made from scraps of fabric.

All the dresses are a length of fabric, elastic at the neckline & bias tape for the ties.. Bright colors are the favorites. 100% cotton fabric is necessary because the dresses are going to a hot climate. Each dress needs 12" to 20" of elastic (3/4" braided or woven) and most of a package of EXTRA WIDE DOUBLE FOLD bias tape. They also use leftovers!

Toddler size dress is 20" long.  
Small size dress is 19 - 26" long.  
Medium size dress is 27" - 32" long.  
Large size dress is 33" - 37" long.  
X Large size dress is 8" or more long.

Donating short or long pieces will keep them sewing. And they also use scraps of fabric. Donations of notions will be very welcome.

They will keep sewing with your help. The children in Africa & Guatemala need clothes,

Their coat distribution has seen a record breaking start this year. Around 100 coats were given out on the first day! They could still use the following sizes of coats:

XL, XXL, XXXL for both men & women

They also need:

- girl's size 14 coats
- Stocking hats for smaller (elementary school age) children
- Snow pants of all sizes
- Boots of all sizes.

You can place these items in the New Hope container in the disability area by the elevator.
