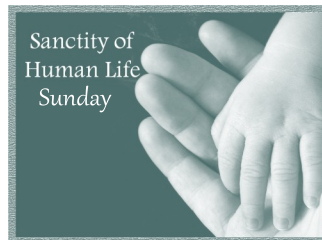

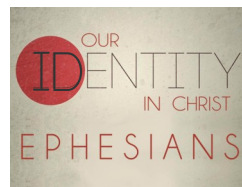

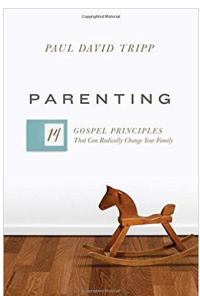
*What is your calling as a parent?*

## FREE BEDROOM SET

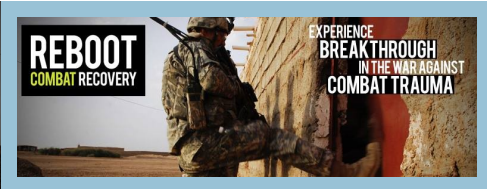

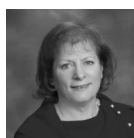

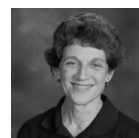
