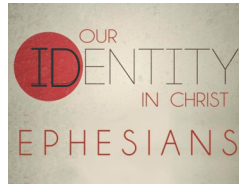

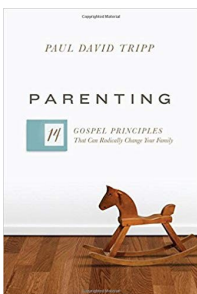
What is your calling as a parent?

FREE BEDROOM SET

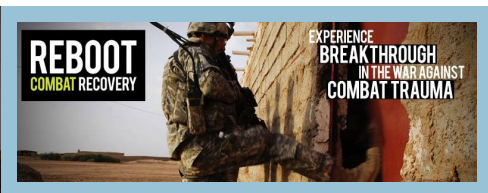

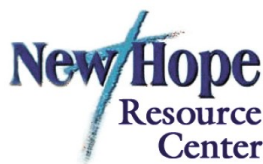


"Youth for Christ" in Spokane is in great need of adult volunteers as leaders during club on Monday and Tuesday evenings.

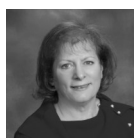

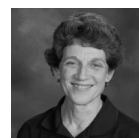
