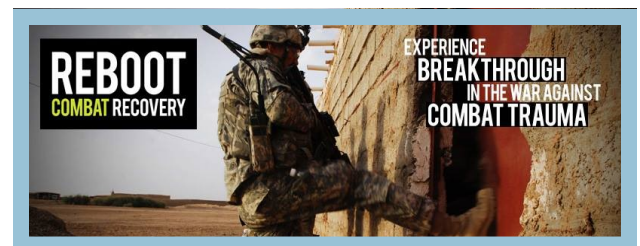

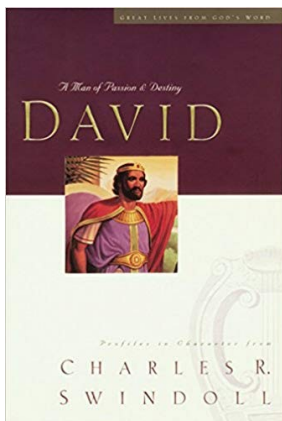

DAVID: A MAN OF PASSION & DESTINY by Charles Swindoll

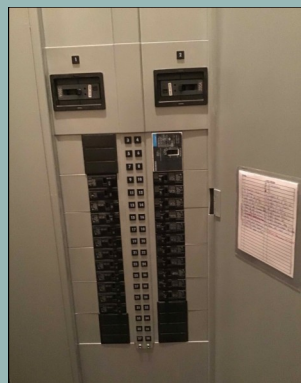
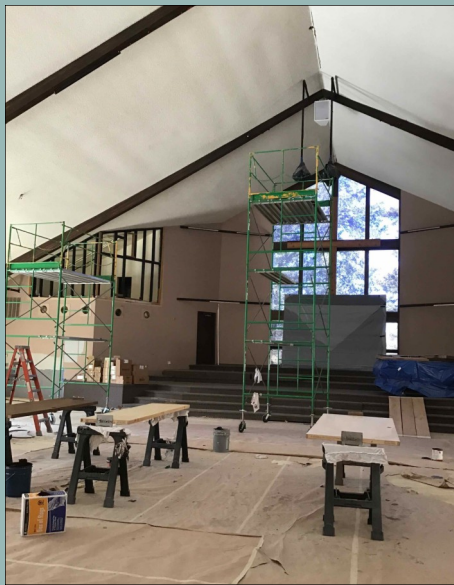
