

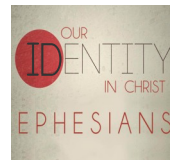

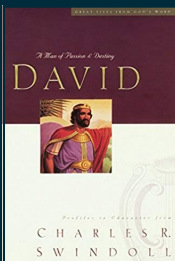

The Northview Christian School is collecting empty frosting cans (like the Betty Crocker kind). Please take your empty cans down to the school office.

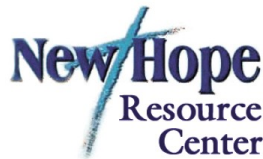


"Youth for Christ" in Spokane is in great need of adult volunteers as leaders during club on Monday and Tuesday evenings.
