

# "The Power of the Heart" by Sharon Reidenbach

The anticipation electrified the crowd gathering for the festivities: It's Passover. The Emperor's Representative will enter Jerusalem with military splendor. It's rumored across town that Jesus will arrive on a donkey, along with Lazarus whom Jesus raised from the dead. With the two opposites in town, the disciples and those among the crowd wonder, "Is this the moment? Is the insurrection about to begin?" (John 7:25) The choreography is set for the perfect eruption of emotions.

When Jesus arrived, "...many spread their clothes, others laid leafy branches on the road for Him." (Mark 11: 8 NKJV) Their tongues forming words shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. The King of Israel!" (John 12:12) Non-stop, men and women confessed from their mouths, "This is the 'Son of David. Hosanna in the highest!" (Matthew 21: 10)

The Jerusalem crowd, praising Jesus, would do anything to find the relief of their burdens. They hoped by voicing tributes of allegiance calling Him "King." He'd take the throne from Rome, especially with its representative conveniently in the area.

But, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue." (Proverbs 18:21) And in a week, after Jesus didn't deliver, the crowds wagged tongues of, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" (John 19:6)

However, the mechanics in the mouth, in and of itself, aren't emotional to produce this *power*. Something has to arouse its positive or negative reaction . . . the *heart*.

May we allow this first Palm Sunday to penetrate our spirit, and act as a mirror to examine which side of the aisle our tongues reveal our true hearts... shouts of hope for immediate help from "The King," like the Jews or voices of abandonment when our prolonged suffering sees no end.

But our magnificent Savior didn't turn around and leave Jerusalem, knowing the people's fickle hearts and false tongues (and ours). With tears, He never wavered from His journey to offer a permanent solution to anything one faces . . . eternal life forever, free of tribulations.

This is what we can lift up from our hearts and with our mouths . . . praises for His unconditional love any time, anywhere, under any conditions!

"With the heart one believes, resulting in righteousness [not evil and with the mouth one confesses [a relationship beyond earthy desires] resulting in salvation." Romans  $10\cdot10$

We can't fill our house until we have enough respite coverage to give our regular house parents the breaks they need.


We need either: 3 more couples or single gals who could volunteer one weekend (Friday evening through Sunday evening) every other month.
