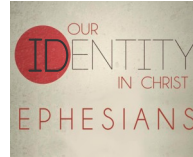


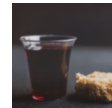

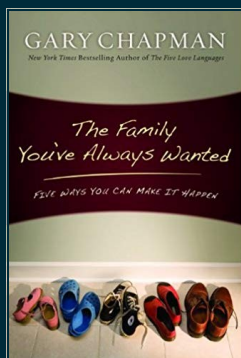

We are people who seek guarantees that nothing in life will fracture our earthly happiness. We read labels, make lists of pros and cons, search for perfect investments, gravitate towards books insuring us success with our family, take the latest vitamins, and pursue those mountain top experiences. It's good and wise to have a plan. The problem? This world *can't* hand us guarantees.

And when life's "sure things" crumble, we're hit head on with the 3-D's: Discouragement, Disappointment, and Disillusionment. In the midst of our turmoil, an alarm should go off causing us to pause and listen.

From the minute to the majestic, we hear nature shout out glory to God. Through the winds gentle whispers we hear, *"The I AM is here. If the universe I set in motion in the beginning from sun, moon, planets and galaxies have never changed neither will My dependable presence in your circumstances. Lean on Me, alone."*

After listening, we'll read His faithful word where God once again chooses His creation to turn our eyes and hearts upward and outward to glorify and Him when the expiration date on earth's effective guarantee's have expired.

"Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord.
