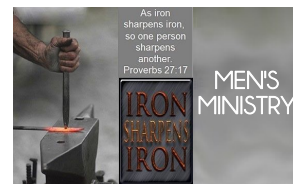

Luke 5:1-11

Speaking Today: Pastor Norm Schwab

Do you long to make a difference . . . an impact? Do you crave to be part of something significant, but right now your spiritual life is flat and your worship is boring? Has sin so wreaked its havoc that you never feel good enough to make a difference? What if it were true that the thing that really qualifies us to belong to Him . . . be used by Him, is not our worthiness, but our unworthiness?

What does the journey toward a vibrant life with Jesus look like?

1. Drink in God's Word. (verses 1-4)
2. Look for opportunities. (Verses 2, 3)
3. Take a baby step. (verse 3)
4. Go deeper . . . take a challenge step. (verse 4)
 - It won't be easy. (verses 5-7)
5. Follow because it's Jesus asking. (verse 5)
6. Go all in. (verses 8-11)
